Roasty, toasty notes from dark malts partnered with the sweetness of molasses and Madagascan vanilla make this the perfect entry level stout for those wishing to venture unknowingly onto the dark side. Once converted crème Bearlee will welcome you time and again into its deliciously sweet embrace. <b>Suitable for vegans, lactose free.</b>
8	Disruption Is Brewing, Camberley, Surrey 	Shadow of a Darkness Cherry Coconut <b>Sponsored by Mid Boldon Club, East Boldon</b>	5	Stout	Adapted from a classic, award-winning recipe. Dark coffee, bitter chocolate with a damning portion of oats gives this stout the ultimate smooth and luscious mouthfeel to die for. This version has toasted coconut and cherry puree added to the brew to create a cherry coconut delight..
9	Brass Castle, Malton 	Five Card Draw <b>Sponsored by The Stags Head South Shields</b>	5	IPA	Nothing hits the spot quite like an IPA, and this 5% American style classic showcases five of the best hops to ever do it. 10	Kirkstall, Leeds 	Black Band Porter <b>Sponsored by Station Espresso Bar East Boldon</b>	5.5	Porter	In celebration of Kirkstall Forge, the oldest forge in England, and named after the giant press that was at the heart of the operation. A full bodied yet beautifully smooth dark porter. Perfectly balanced flavours of chocolate and coffee enhanced by the mild herbal hop character. Deliciously dark. <b>Lactose free</b>
11	Five Towns/ Fernandez, Wakefield 	Junkie <b>Sponsored by Pivovar, York</b>	7.3	IPA	A single hopped IPA, with English Harlequin hops
12	Durham 	Sumerian <b>Sponsored by The Station House, Durham</b>	8.4	Golden	Brewed to celebrate our 30th Anniversary. The oldest beer recipe in history. Created from the Sumerian Hymn to Ninkasi circa 1750 BC. Ninkasi was the Sumerian goddess of brewing and beer. We've used local Humble Bee honey, dates and spices; creating a beer some have described as liquid banana bread. The aroma is an alchemy of spices that would have been available in ancient Mesopotamia.

We've been experimenting with a bunch of CGX hop varieties from Crosby Hops, thanks to the good folks at Loughran Brewers Select. With this dynamic duo, we blended CGX and T90 to craft two Pale Ales that are same, same, but different—coming together like Yin and Yang. Dry-hopped with El Dorado CGX, Yang brings an explosion of berry and tropical fruity madness to Yin. Try it with it's other half: Yin To My Yang

4	Brew York 	Mixed Berry Blend	5	Pale	We've partnered with Hebden Tea to craft a Mixed Berry Tea Pale. This refreshing pale ale features an exquisitely elegant tea blend, delivering fruity aromas of rich elderberries, succulent grapes, and tart blackberries, raspberries, and blackcurrants

3	Dudda's Tun Sittingbourne Kent 	Sweet Apple <b>Sponsored by Blues Micro Pub, Whitburn</b>	5.5	Sweet	Light gold in colour and with a sweet apple aroma, this is a delicately sweet tasting cider

A deep gold mal platform is backing up this hero hop; Best, Crystal 150 and Cara provide the West Coast subtle sweet depth.
2	Tapped Brew Co, Sheffield 	Jericho	4	APA	Our US hopped American Pale Ale brewed with Cascade, Chinook, Centennial and El Dorado.
3	Wilde Child, Leeds 	Delaying the Inevitable	4.2	Session IPA	A classic style IPA brewed using Amarillo & Ekuanot hops which equal fantastic aromas of pineapple, peach and grapefruit. <b>Suitable for vegans, lactose free</b>
4	Bang the Elephant, Nottingham 	Thunder Cats	4.8	Pale	Pale Ale - New England / Hazy
5	Swanney, Orkney 	Orkney IPA	4.8	IPA	Literally all our beer has been upon the waves, albeit only for an hour or so (on a calm day!) on the ferry from Orkney.
